

Corvette Center Open House April 2nd, 2022



The open house at the Corvette Center in Newington was widely attended by Club Corvette members and other Corvette enthusiasts enjoying an in- depth tour. Ray Zisa, a 23-year member of Club Corvette of Connecticut, wife Erika and son Zack led the tours, helped park cars, and served refreshments to all attending. The Corvette Center, established in 1978 provides full automotive services including performance enhancements, body work and painting, and interior restorations. Current projects included fuel injecting a classic GTO, a meticulously restored 1966 Corvette coupe, a C7 Corvette requiring extensive body work, and a beautifully restored Olds 442. The Corvette Center offerings also includes fine tuning via a chassis dyno, a process used to calculate horsepower from torque value. Most chassis dynos have the capability to monitor air/fuel ratios (via an O2 sensor in the exhaust) and other engine parameters. The chassis dynamometer's claim to fame is the ability to measure power at the drive wheels-the "real world" performance of a vehicle. You can make tuning changes and test parts to find out the effects on power. This certainly was a day well spent, the workmanship provided is excellent and their full- service offerings will certainly meet the needs of any car enthusiast.



Corvette Trivia for April '22



The Pit Stop

Corvette Racing at Sebring What a Win!!!

Corvette Racing made it the twelfth victory in the Mobil 1 Twelve Hours of Sebring, the first victory in America's oldest sports car race for the mid-engine Chevrolet Corvette C8.R, and the first win since 2017 at Sebring.

Antonio Garcia, Jordan Taylor, and Nicky Catsburg teamed for the landmark win with the No. 3 Mobil 1/SiriusXM Corvette in the second round of the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship. The trio combined to lead 247 laps or 913.9 miles for Corvette Racing's first Sebring 12 Hours win since 2017 and 12th since 2002.

"Congratulations to Antonio Garcia, Jordan Taylor, Nicky Catsburg, and everyone on the No. 3 Corvette C8.R team," said Jim Campbell, Chevrolet U.S. vice president, Performance and Motorsports. "Winning in class for the 12th time at the 12 Hours of Sebring is the result of great driving, race strategy and execution of pit stops. The Corvette C8.R's 5.5liter, flat-plane V-8 engine delivered the right combination of performance, reliability and efficiency throughout the race.

Corvette Racing's next event in the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship is April 8-9 at the Long Beach (Calif.) street circuit.

According to Keith Cornett at Corvette Blogger, IMSA's BoP stewards wouldn't let that runaway Sebring win by the C8.R go unchecked.

The IMSA Technical Bulletin assigns an additional 10 kg of weight and a 0.4 mm smaller air restrictor, as well as a decrease of 4-liters of fuel for Corvette Racing. Those changes are the equivalent of an 8.3 horsepower decrease for the C8.Rs from their previous set-up at Sebring. The total weight now in the C8.Rs ballast box is 50 kg as IMSA attempts to balance the car to others in the GTD-Pro class. The C8.R is racing with a waiver this year due to it not being a true GT3 car.

Corvette Set for 1st Single Car IMSA Race

Corvette Racing is still trying to get used to the new GTD spec'ed Corvette C8.R and will now have a "new challenge" in running as a single-car operation. The team has not run a single car IMSA race in more than 20 years.

The Pratt & Miller-run factory squad will enter a solo Corvette C8.R in Saturday's Mobil 1 Twelve Hours of Sebring, with their resources split this year between single-car efforts in the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship and FIA World Endurance Championship.

With Tommy Milner and Nick Tandy in the team's WEC GTE-Pro entry this weekend, Nicky Catsburg will team up with reigning GTLM class champions Antonio Garcia and Jordan Taylor in the WeatherTech Championship season-long No. 3 entry in GTD Pro.

The team ran two GTD Pro cars in January's season-opener at Daytona although is expected to remain a single-car team for the majority of the remaining WeatherTech Championship rounds this year.

Nonetheless, Sebring will mark the first time since the 2000 American Le Mans Series season that the team has run only one car in a race stateside.

Corvette Gains 16% Markwt Share to lead the Premium Sports Car Segment

With the release of the <u>1st Quarter 2022 sales figures</u> from GM, we can now take a closer look at how they compare with the competition in the Premium Sports Car segment.

Chevrolet sales for the 1st quarter 2022 increased 33.3% to 8,811 units over the same time period in 2021. What's really impressive is that the Chevrolet sold 4,000 more Corvettes than all the other competitors in the segment combined! Chevrolet now has a 68% share of the Premium Sports Car Sales which was an increase of 5% over the 63% market share the Corvette had at the end of 2021 and it's up a whopping 16% year over year!

Porsche's 911 was second in the segment with sales of 2,123 for the quarter while sales of the 4th place Porsche 718 came in with a 6% market share and 782 cars delivered. Combining both models for Porsche results in the German automaker holding a 23% market share with 2,905 total sales. In third place was the Mercedes Benz AMG GT with 942 cars delivered during the time period. Sales of the AMG GT are down 22.3% over last year. The Audi R8 rounds out the top five with a 1% market share on 68 cars sold during the quarter. Sales year over year of the R8 are down 54%.

Artifact of the Month Grady Davis/Don Yenko Croton Watch

Long before the 8 victories at Le Mans and the 14 Championships won by the factorybased Corvette Racing team, there were only the "privateer" race teams campaigning Corvette. Because of a voluntary ban on racing by GM, it took people like Tommy Morrison, John Greenwood, Tony DeLorenzo, Jer Thompson, Doug Bergen, Bob Johnson, and others to build Corvette's reputation as a competitor. Before all of them though, it was the Grady Davis Gulf Oil Racing Corvettes driven by Don Yenko and Dick Thompson, that were making history...



Grady Davis / Don Yenko Croton Watch

On June 11, 1955, Le Mans became the site of the worst disaster in motorsports history, when a car went off track into the crowd, killing 83 spectators and the driver. In response to this tragedy and a desire to avoid government intervention, GM joined others from the Automobile Manufacturers Association, and agreed to a ban on motorsports activity.

The desire to see and experience sports car racing continued though, so it was then that "privateer" racers took the wheel. Privateers bought their Corvettes from the dealership with whatever performance options they could get, and then modified them for racing. For teams that did well, they might begin to see "heavy-duty" parts show up from Chevrolet Engineering for "testing" on track.

Grady Davis, Vice President of Gulf Oil, was one such privateer. Using Gulf Oil research and development resources, and some clandestine heavy-duty help from Chevy engineers, he was able to give his drivers Corvettes that could win.

For drivers, he connected with Chevrolet dealer and racer, Don Yenko. Don was fiercely competitive, and a person who could understand what his cars were doing mechanically. Later he would become best known for his Yenko Camaros.

Dick Thompson, aka the "Flying Dentist" was on the team as well. Together Dick and Don began driving Corvettes for Gulf Oil Racing in 1961 and won the National Championship that year.

On February 11, 1962, Davis, Yenko and Thompson brought their Corvettes to the opening race in the World Sports Car Championship series at Daytona International Speedway. The two Gulf Oil Corvettes came in 1st and 2nd, with another Corvette privateer taking 3rd for a Corvette podium sweep. The team would go on to take the B Production class championship in 1962 and 1963 with Gulf Oil Corvettes.

This Croton watch was given to Don Yenko by Grady Davis after the 1963 racing season. The watch is engraved "To Don from Grady '63" on the back.


