Spring Into Corvette Season

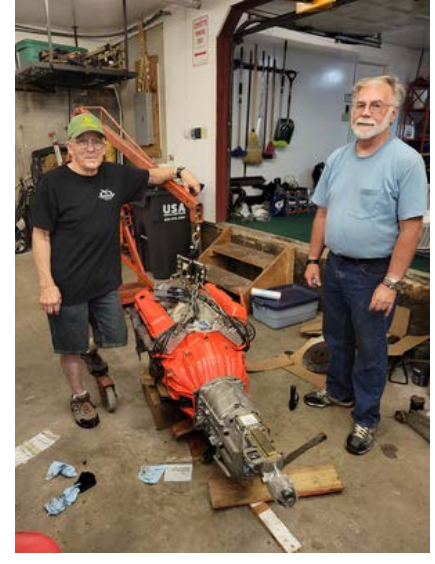

Mark your calendar for June 28, 2026, as Member Appreciation Day returns to the National Corvette Museum. Members are invited to participate in an on-site car show alongside R8C Reunion participants, creating a shared celebration of Corvette ownership, plus other Members-only experiences. More details, including a formal RSVP invitation, will be shared later this spring.

Opening March 12, the new Driven to Preserve exhibition features a standout race veteran: a 1967 Corvette Stingray nicknamed “Sweat Hog.” Purchased in 1971 by racer Bill Engel Jr., it was quickly rebuilt for competition and helped Tri Vettes Ltd (East Greenbush, New York) capture the 1974 North East NCCC championship. Marked by real racing history with period repairs and a later engine rebuild, it remains about 85% original today.

March Milestone:

The Corvette that Launched a New Era

In March 1983, GM delivered the first fourth-generation Corvettes (model years 1984-1996) to customers, moving straight into the 1984 model year after production delays effectively skipped a public 1983 release. With its wedge styling, digital dashboard, and sharper handling, this Corvette helped define the modern, tech-forward chapter of America's Sports Car, a legacy the National Corvette Museum preserves and shares every day through collection, preservation, and education.

Did you know?

Fourth-generation Corvettes represent the largest share of Corvette generations in the National Corvette Museum collection, including the only surviving 1983 pilot car, ZR-1s, and commemorative Corvettes like the Malcolm Konner Corvette. ²⁷

There's been plenty of speculation revolving around the C9 Corvette as of late, fueled even further by a pair of purely experimental concepts that GM rolled out not too terribly long ago. However, the most recent addition to the C8 lineup may give us our best clue yet as to when the C9 might arrive – the Grand Sport, and Grand Sport X, specifically. In a recent appearance on The Gas podcast, Corvette Chief Engineer Josh Holder confirmed that the 2027 Grand Sport is, in fact, the beginning of the end for the C8 generation model, in fact.
